



March Bus Trips

March 4: Titanic An Immersive Voyage, Schenectady Armory. Lunch to follow at Druthers Brewing Company. Step Back in Time: An Unforgettable Journey Aboard the Titanic. This isn't just a museum—it's a trip back to 1912. Upon entry, you'll receive a replica boarding pass of an actual passenger, allowing you to follow their specific journey through the ship's halls. Walk through the Grand Staircase and see meticulously reconstructed First and Third-Class cabins. View personal belongings, chinaware, and pieces of the ship recovered from the deep. Feel the chill of the North Atlantic and learn the heroic stories of those on board and discover the surprising links between the Titanic and the Capital District. **Admission to the Titanic \$23.90. The bus departs at 10:00 AM.**

March 10 – Troy City Music Hall, Music at Noon. Lunch to follow at Capital City Diner. The Oxalis Trio is a flute, oboe, and piano trio based in the Hudson Valley. They perform music by a wide range of composers, from the well-known to the obscure. At their concerts, you'll nearly always hear something you've never heard before, leaving you invigorated and inspired. March 19: Saratoga Trifecta: Racino, Saratoga Auto Museum or Shopping in downtown Saratoga. Name your pleasure and our driver will happily take you to your destination! Will it be Racino or strolling down Broadway in beautiful downtown Saratoga and shopping in the unique boutiques before having lunch at one of the many restaurants and eateries, or will it be the Auto Museum to see Pontiac: The Dawn of Muscle brings together Pontiac's most iconic performance machines.
