HIGHWAY DEPARTMENT

Chapter 270, Zoning.

Highway Permit fees for all contractors shall be as follows:

Work to be performed	Fee
Full road cut	\$750.00 on up to 100 square feet
Cut on pavement not to exceed ½ road cut	\$375.00 on up to 50 square feet
Shoulder cut	\$200.00
Cuts over 100 square feet	\$7.50 per square foot

All public utilities that provide their own restoration shall pay a permit fee of 20¢ per linear foot of trench. The minimum fee for all public utilities shall be \$100.00.

Public utilities shall share a common trench. The public utility applying for the permit shall be responsible for the payment of all fees, the supplying of paints, and the restoration of the project. The Superintendent of Highways has the option to have the contractor complete all of the paving on large projects that may require an asphalt paver. If the contractor completes the paving, then a permit fee of \$100.00 will be charged.
