BENEFITS OF DOG LICENSING

Dog licensing is required by New York State law and helps protect your pet if they become lost. A valid license tag allows Animal Control to quickly identify your dog and contact you. Licensed dogs are also held longer at shelters, giving owners more time to reunite with their pets.

Licensing also helps ensure dogs stay current on rabies vaccinations, protecting both pets and the community. Failure to license your dog may result in fines, penalties, and possible court action.

FOR PUBLIC HEALTH

Rabies is a serious threat to both people and animals. Dog licensing helps ensure dogs are properly vaccinated, reducing public health risks and preventing costly rabies-related incidents for taxpayers.

VOLUNTARY SHELTER DONATION

Pursuant to New York State Senate Bill S1373, this application includes an option for owners to make a voluntary contribution to support the Montgomery County SPCA, the animal shelter utilized by the Town of Rotterdam for dogs taken into custody.
